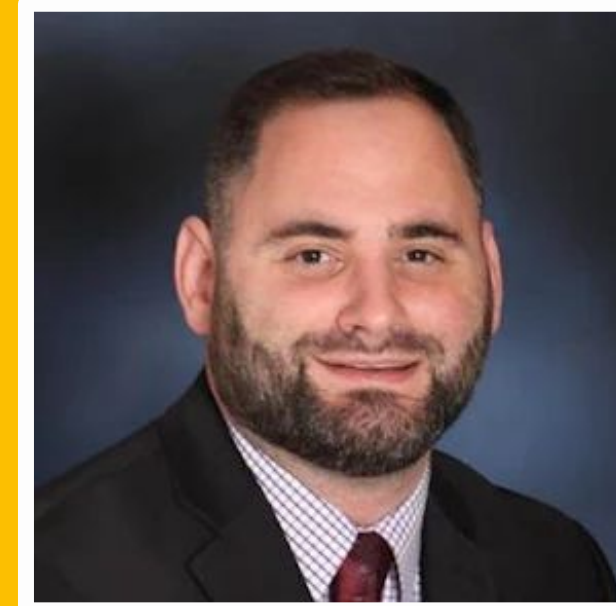

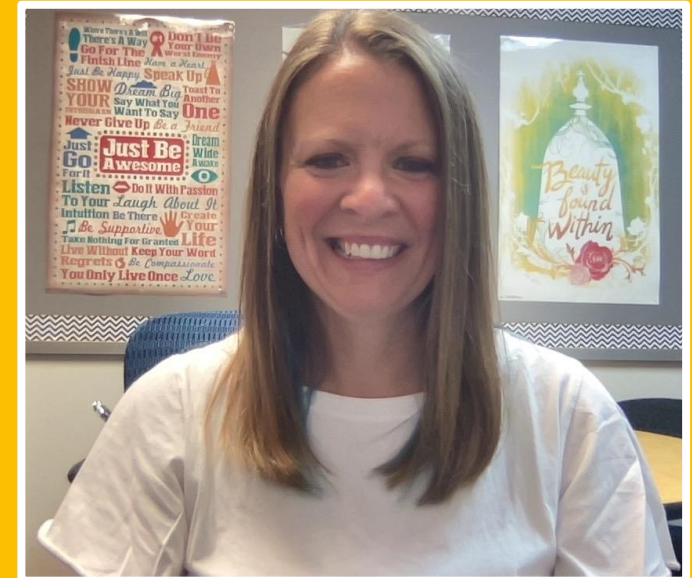

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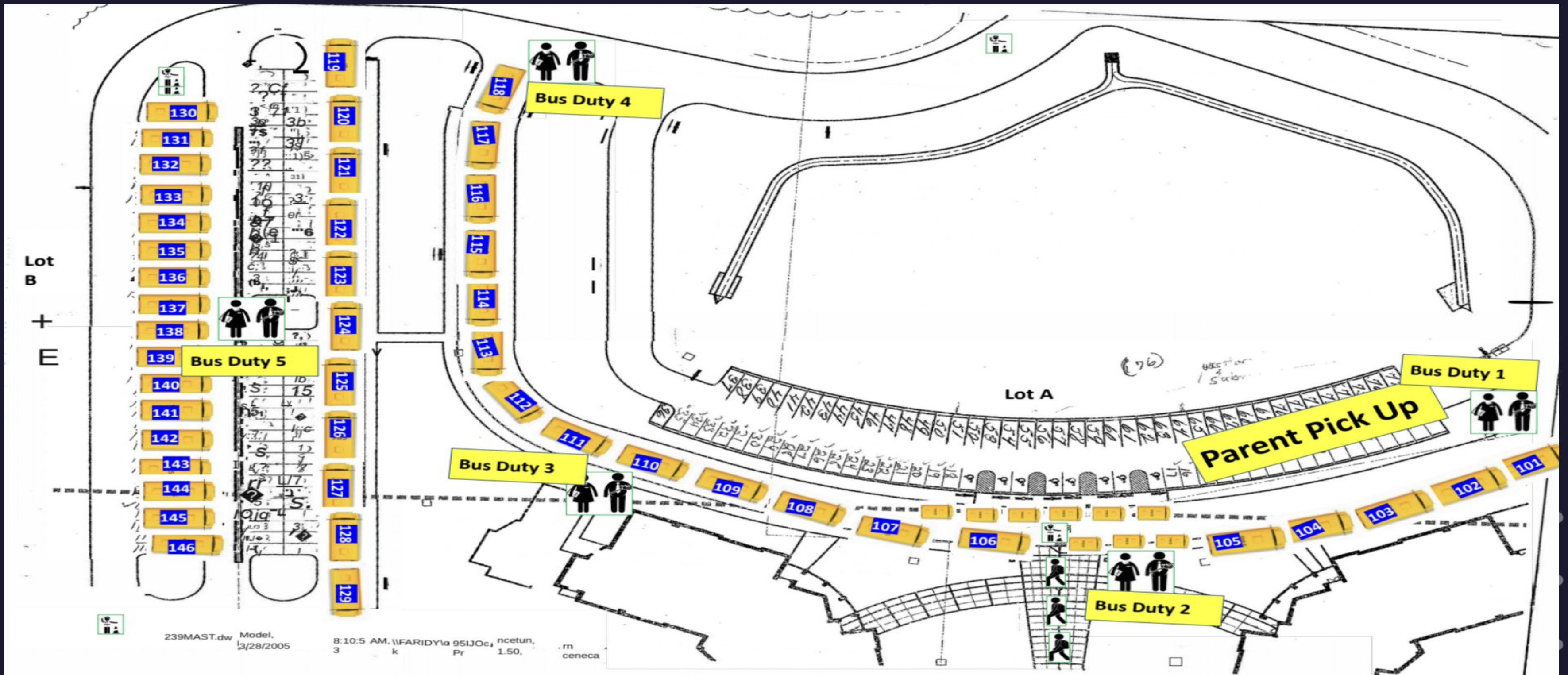

# Reporting an Absence

- Please call the office at 732-302-4200 extension 6708 to report your child's absence.
- Please bring a written note upon returning to school and place it in the attendance box located in the main lobby or email note to [FHSAttendance@franklinboe.org](mailto:FHSAttendance@franklinboe.org) from a parent or guardian's personal email address.
- Notes must be submitted no later than 5 days after the student returns or absences will be marked as "Verified; unexcused"
- Parent notes can only cover consecutive 3 days. After 3 consecutive days, a family has to submit a doctor or legal note.
- An automated phone call will be generated to inform parents/guardians each time a student is marked absent.
- Letters will be available in Genesis and by mail for absences in excess of 4, 8, and 10 days.

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

# Dress Code Expectations

<b>Head Area</b> No caps, visors, jacket hoods, bandanas, sweatshirt hoods, doo-rags, headbands or any other head gear, except with Administrative permission.	<b>Acceptable</b> 	<b>Not Acceptable</b> 
<b>Upper Garments</b> No halter tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps or muscle shirts. No explicit graphics may show. All garments must cover shoulder to shoulder. No rips/tears or skintight items. All garments must be long enough to clearly overlap the beltline or stay tucked.	<b>Acceptable</b> 	<b>Not Acceptable</b> 
<b>Foot Covering</b> No flip flops, sandals or open toed shoes are permitted.	<b>Acceptable</b> 	<b>Not Acceptable</b> 
<b>Lower Garments - Male</b> Undergarments and the buttocks MUST remain entirely covered even while you are seated. Pants and shorts must be at the waist and without tears/rips.	<b>Acceptable</b> 	<b>Not Acceptable</b> 
<b>Lower Garments - Female</b> Dresses, skirts and shorts must be at least mid-thigh or below in length. No yoga pants, leggings, rip/tears or skintight items are permitted.	<b>Acceptable</b> 	<b>Not Acceptable</b> 

The administration will make the final determination as to whether clothing in question is in violation of the dress code. Parents/guardians have a responsibility to assist students in being compliant with the dress code before they leave home for school. Teachers are expected to model the behaviors that we expect from students.

All staff are expected to dress professionally.

# Class Cutting :

Students who are absent from any assigned scheduled class period without a valid excuse provided by a teacher, nurse, counselor, dean, or administrator are subject to disciplinary consequences for cutting class.

## CONSEQUENCES FOR CUTTING CLASS :

Students who cut classes, will not be eligible to attend or participate in their respective current/scheduled/upcoming Clubs/Events/ Sporting Events or Fine Visual and Performing Arts performances or School Sponsored Events.

This decision will be made by the Grade Level Vice Principal, Principal or/and Athletic Director. Parents will be notified by FHS Administration or FHS Athletic Director



# Tobacco & Vaping Pens:

Vape investigations are initially considered as a tobacco product offense. If a student is suspected of Vaping, then a search should be done.

1st offense Possession of a Vape Pen - Send student out for testing  
**(2 Days of ISS & Mandatory SAC Sessions)**

2nd offense Possession of a Vape Pen-Send student out for testing  
**(2 Days of OSS & Mandatory SAC Sessions)**

3rd offense Possession/Usage of Vape Pen Send student out for testing  
**(5 Days of OSS & Mandatory SAC Sessions)**

Students who are found to be in possession of a Vaping Pen are **REQUIRED** to complete the VAPING PREVENTION AND EDUCATION QUIZ prior to their return to school, as a part of our vaping prevention initiative.

Parents understand that if the quiz is not completed prior to the student returning to school, the student will be placed in ISS to complete the module before they can return to class.

# FHS Student Chromebook Distribution & Management
