



**Guidelines for Senior Citizen Gold Card
Available to Franklin Township Residents 60 years of Age and Older**

This card can be used for Board of Education sponsored events **only such as school district performances and sporting events**. This card does **not** include PTO sponsored breakfasts, luncheons, dinners or any other fundraisers or activities.

This card can only be used by the person to whom the card was issued. Photo ID will be required to gain entrance at events. To reserve your seat at an event with this card, you must call the school or event directly to let them know you will be using your Gold Card. Reservations are required and seating availability may be limited. ***One free ticket per card, per event. You must show your Gold Card along with a photo ID to receive entrance into an event.***

You will need photo identification and proof of Franklin residency along with your date of birth to obtain a card. You cannot obtain a card for someone other than yourself.
