
CLOSE CONTACTS: THOSE EXPOSED ON DAY 1-5

ARE YOU:

- 12 YEARS OLD OR OVER, FULLY VACCINATED & **BOOSTED** (IF ELIGIBLE) OR
- 5-11 YEARS OLD & FULLY VACCINATED OR
- HAVE HAD COVID-19 IN THE PAST 90 DAYS



YOU SHOULD HAVE A **COVID TEST** AT LEAST 5* **DAYS AFTER EXPOSURE**

IF YOU HAVE HAD COVID WITHIN 90 DAYS THERE IS NO NEED TO **TEST**

YOU MAY **RETURN TO** THE SCHOOL **BUILDING****

BUT YOU MUST FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES **BELOWFOR 10 DAYS**

IF TEST IS **POSITIVE: ISOLATE AT** HOME & FOLLOW **POSITIVE** PERSON **PROTOCOL**

IF TEST IS **NEGATIVE:** YOU MAY **RETURN TO** THE SCHOOL BUILDING AND YOU **MUST FOLLOW GUIDELINES** BELOW FOR 5 DAYS**



RETURN TO SCHOOL GUIDELINES

- WEAR A MASK INDOORS & OUTDOORS
- MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE AT LUNCH TO **EXTENT POSSIBLE**
- KEEP MASK ON FOR PE, MUSIC & DANCE
- DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN ATHLETICS
- DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN EXTRACURRICULAR **ACTIVITIES WITHOUT A MASK**
- DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN CARE

**If the district has lifted the mask mandate, generally students who are close contacts and in grades 6-12 must quarantine for 10 days. However, students who are close contacts in grades 6-12 may return on day 8 with proof of a negative PCR test taken between days 5 and 7. Additionally, students who are close contacts and in grades 6-12 may be able to participate in school sponsored activities outside of school hours on day 6-10 of the quarantine period provided they are fully vaccinated and up to date with their vaccines and wear a mask throughout the activity. Permission for this exception must be sought from the building principal. 5/9/22
