August 20, 2015	Student Placement	When they are registered, students in grades K-4 are assigned to an elementary school within their transportation/attendance areas. Within some transportation/attendance areas, there are two elementary schools. Students may be placed in either of these schools. Factors that are considered when placing a student in one or the other of these schools include: seat availability at that grade level; proximity to the students household; and current enrollment of a sibling at that school. Due to the number of students who are placed each year, parental preferences are not considered. In some cases, students are placed in programs outside of their transportation/attendance zone, for example if they require a special education program, offered at a particular school. Transportation is provided for these students.
		In order to accommodate the greatest amount of students in our pre-school program, some students may be offered a seat in a pre-school program in a school outside of their transportation/attendance area. In these cases, since pre-school is not a mandated program, parents are responsible for their child's transportation.
