August 20, 2015	Student Placement	<p>When they are registered, students in grades K-4 are assigned to an elementary school within their transportation/attendance areas. Within some transportation/attendance areas, there are two elementary schools. Students may be placed in either of these schools. Factors that are considered when placing a student in one or the other of these schools include: seat availability at that grade level; proximity to the students household; and current enrollment of a sibling at that school. Due to the number of students who are placed each year, parental preferences are not considered.</p> <p>In some cases, students are placed in programs outside of their transportation/attendance zone, for example if they require a special education program, offered at a particular school. Transportation is provided for these students.</p> <p>In order to accommodate the greatest amount of students in our pre-school program, some students may be offered a seat in a pre-school program in a school outside of their transportation/attendance area. In these cases, since pre-school is not a mandated program, parents are responsible for their child's transportation.</p>
