Whereas, the Franklin Township Board of Education recognizes that some parents/guardians in Franklin Township choose to educate their children through a home school program and that those programs often do not allow for social interaction with other students, and

Whereas, the Franklin Township Public Schools provides a variety of extracurricular opportunities, including athletics, for the students enrolled in the District schools, and

Whereas, applicable law and the guidelines from the New Jersey Department of Education do not prohibit nor compel a Board of Education to allow homeschooled children who are residents of the school District from participating in extracurricular activities including athletics, and

Whereas, current Franklin Township Board of Education Policies 6145 Extracurricular Activities and 6145.1/6145.2 Intramural Competitions and Interscholastic Competitions do not specifically speak to the inclusion or exclusion of homeschooled children who are residents of the District in extracurricular activities, and

Whereas, the Superintendent has received a request for participation in the Franklin High School Fall Soccer Program from one such homeschooled student, identified here as L.D. and

Whereas, the Superintendent has recommended that, in the absence of policy, this individual be allowed to participate in extracurricular athletics at Franklin High School for the fall season, and

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the individual referred to herein as L.D. be allowed to participate in extracurricular athletics at Franklin High School for the fall season, and

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Franklin Township Board of Education will clarify its policy governing the participation of homeschooled children who reside in the District in extracurricular activities provided by the Board of Education.
