**Cadet Staff Ride to Washington DC Trip (Pentagon) to be conducted from April 27 through April 29, 2016:**

#### **Objectives:**

- a. Allow cadets that participated in the JROTC Program for 4 years (seniors) an opportunity to capture an overall view of all historical curriculum lesson taught throughout the 4 years in the program.
- b. Allow cadets a chance to participate in citizenship building exercises.
- c. Allow cadets to participate in a staff ride to conduct preliminary study and formal analysis of U.S. historical sites.
- d. Involve cadets in an educational field trip to provide them with real world insight into today's military organization and government functions.
- e. Allow to place cadets on an actual piece of terrain, confront them with an operational situation, and stimulate them to reach conclusions or derive lessons from the experience.
- f. Allow cadets to conduct historical study, particularly with personal reconnaissance that offers valuable opportunities to develop professional leadership and knowledge.

#### **Sites to be visit:**

1. The Pentagon
2. The Pentagon Memorial: Is a memorial commemorating the September 11, 2001 terrorist attack on the Pentagon and the 184 innocent lives lost in the Pentagon and on American Airline Flight 77.
3. The United States Capitol: The best recognized symbol of democratic government in the world. It has housed Congress since 1800 and is where they meet to write the law of our nation and where presidents are inaugurated and deliver their annual State of the Union messages. Cadets will visit the House Chamber, Rotunda, Old Senate Chamber, Senate Chamber, National Statuary Hall, Capital Dome, Galleries, and the offices of their senators and representatives.
4. Arlington National Cemetery: Shelter veterans from every war that has involved the nation. Cadets will also visit the Memorial Amphitheater, Arlington House, Confederate Monument, Women's Memorial, and attend the timeless rituals of honor at the Tomb of the Unknowns.
