##### Detailed Explanation

Critical to understanding the waiver request is to note that the numbers of students in Section B reflect the total number of ELLs in each grade level and in all proficiencies. Based on our tiered program, a small fraction of those students are at level 1&2 and therefore would be those students who would qualify for bilingual support.

Geographic location is not an issue for students to receive services in Franklin. Although we have neighborhood schools, or zoned schools at the elementary and middle school levels, when a student is eligible for ESL and/or bilingual services, we provide transportation to a school where the services are offered (Pine Grove Manor for bilingual and all but two of the elementary schools for ESL; Sampson G. Smith for middle grades). This has allowed us to maintain our full time program in K-2 and to have opened a bilingual grade 3 home room this 18-19 school year. It has also allowed us to consolidate resources in one elementary school (Pine Grove Manor) and one middle school (Sampson G. Smith). Part-time bilingual services are offered in LAL and Math for students in grades 4-8. At the high school level we have consistently offered bilingual Math and are very pleased to report that in the 19-20 school year we will be adding bilingual LAL.

In addition to a part-time bilingual program as an alternative, it is also important to note that we provide additional supports for all of our level 1 & 2 students at the secondary level. At the high school level, we provide high -intensity ESL for all level 1 & 2 students and in grades 6-12 we provide sheltered/co-taught classes in Science and Social Studies. At the elementary level, we combine a pull-out period plus at least one push-in period of ESL.

## Reason

## Detailed Explanation

We organize our program by proficiency level and language dominance, providing bilingual support to Spanish speaking students at levels 1 & 2. The number of students who qualify for bilingual education in grades 4-12 is relatively small, making it impractical to provide a full time program in every grade. They are, therefore supported with a bilingual part-time program as well as high intensity ESL. In grades K-3, we have sufficient students to continue Spanish bilingual homerooms (grade 3 was new this year). In grades 4 - 12 we provide bilingual part-time support, offering bilingual Language Arts and bilingual Math to all level 1 & 2 Spanish speakers. Bilingual LAL will be new at the high school level in SY 19-20.

For Gujarati speakers, grade span is an issue given that the 34 students are spread out between 13 grade levels, and that just a fraction of those are at levels 1 & 2 (and would therefore qualify for bilingual support). The structure of the alternative program and level of support for Gujarati speakers is the same, except for bilingual support. We provide high intensity ESL for elementary students and in the secondary grades we also provide co-taught, Sheltered Science and Social Studies for all students for whom a waiver is requested (level 1 and 2 students).
