**1. Capital Projects**

- Renovations to the Franklin High School Turf and Track are scheduled to begin on July 20<sup>th</sup>.
- The phase 1 renovation at the community center is substantially complete. The district is currently reviewing cost estimates in order to bid the remaining work.
- The Hamilton Street window panel project is currently ongoing. Spartan Construction is in the process of painting the exterior façade and installing window panels.
- All framing is complete at the secure vestibule projects at Franklin Park and Hillcrest schools. Tri-form construction is awaiting the delivery of ballistic glass.
