Franklin High School In-Person Commencement Ceremony Plan

- Ceremony Dates: July 13th, July 14th, and July 15th (Rain dates: July 16th and July 17th).
- Two in-person ceremonies per day one at 10 AM and one at 5 PM.
- Ceremonies limited to 90 graduates and 4 guests = 450 people.
- Ceremony support staff limited to 30 staff members including safety officers, administrators, teachers, and local police officers.
- Estimated total number of people outside on campus = 480 people.
- Guests must have their own face covering and wear it upon entering the venue.
- Franklin Warrior face coverings will be issued to the Class of 2020. Graduates
 will wear the face covering during the ceremony at all times with the exception of
 when posing for their graduation picture (no one will be within six feet of the
 graduate at this time).
- Arrival via the Heller Park Entrance to the Franklin High School Campus (Elizabeth Avenue entrance will be blocked off).
- Access to campus will be limited starting at 9:45 AM for the AM graduation ceremony and 4:45 PM for the afternoon graduation ceremony.
- Graduates should arrive 1 hour prior to the ceremony (9 AM and 4 PM) for staging.
- Physical distancing signage will be displayed on the fencing of the stadium.
- Marcations will be made on the ground and in the Warrior Stadium home side stands to promote physical distancing of graduates and audience.
- Restroom Facilities will be available for the public in the Warrior Stadium Concession area. Usage of the facilities will be limited to 3 persons at any one time, less than 25% of each restroom's capacity. A safety officer will be posted at restroom facilities to ensure capacity restrictions are maintained.
- Graduates will leave the stadium along with recessional music.
- All graduates and guests will be prompted to leave the Franklin High School Campus at the immediate conclusion of the ceremony.
