New Business:

The committee approved the following items:

- A motion to approve a new Sound Studio course for Grades 9-12. This course allows students to learn about music production and the music industry.
- A motion to approve Bunker Hill field trip dates for elementary schools for the 2021-2022 SY.
- Motion to authorize attendance at Sheltered Instruction Training (Title III) professional development. This PD is delivered to general education and content area teachers about working with English Learners
- Motion to acknowledge receipt of the FTPS District Equity Plan Action Steps, for the 2021-2022 SY. Working on these action steps will help the district realize its equity goals for the upcoming school year.
- Motion to authorize the acceptance of the ARP-ESSER Grant in the amount of \$5,802,729. These funds will allow the district to continue planning for a safe return to school for all students as well as to contribute to learning recovery efforts over the next three school years.
