The Committee reviewed and discussed revised Policy 5330.04 Administering Opioid Antidote. This revision reflects guidance from the NJ DOE which was not included in the original law and prior version of the Policy.

The Committee reviewed and discussed three new policies: Policy 2421 Career Technical Education which provides details on the district's Career Technical Education Program, both the FHS CTE Program and the program with the Somerset County Vocational and Technical High School; Policy 5460.02 Bridge Year Pilot Program which provides details on this program available to students this year and next school year; and Policy 5111.01 Use of Search Platforms to Confirm Eligibility of Resident/Non Resident Students, this is a district specific Policy created to make clear the designated purpose of a new search platform to be utilized by the Attendance Officer to investigate potential residency issues.

The Committee also reviewed two regulations pertaining to Administering Opioid Antidote and the Bridge Year Pilot Program which provide more specific details in these areas.

The Committee discussed and agreed to change the date of the upcoming Committee meetings. The July meeting will now be held on Monday, July 12 and the August meeting will now be held on Tuesday, August 17, 2021.
