New Business:

The committee discussed the following proposals for Board consideration:

- A motion to approve a memorandum of agreement between FTPS and Seton Hall's Project Acceleration Dual Enrollment Program in the following math courses: Pre-Calculus CEP, Honors Calculus, Statistics, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, and AP Statistics.
- A motion to approve acceptance of a Perkins Loan in the amount of \$19,902. These funds are used to support the district's Career and Technical Education programs.
- A motion to approve Road to Success program adjustments to begin in September 2023.
- A motion to approve the IXL platform for use in Grades 6-8 Math and ELA, beginning in September 2023.
- A motion to approve Sheltered Instruction training dates and costs for the 2023-2024 school year. This training helps teachers utilize protocols that help current and former English learners to access curriculum content and English learning objectives effectively.
